Activity Report:-

The Seminar was conducted under the chairmanship of Prof Smt Swarnlata Mishra. Prof Sarat Kumar Mohapatra joined hand as a resource person and presented view on the topic. Other faculties kept their views on the topic. Three nos of students presented their paper on the topic.

Abstract of the Topic:-

In this era of coalition politics, when all the national pol. parties have come to realize the need for securing the support of regional parties for getting power at the Centre as well as states, this has made them realize the need for accommodating the demand for state autonomy by avoiding pol. interference in the states ruled by regional parties and by accepting the transfer of some additional financial resources to the states.

In this era of coalition politics, Central Govt tries to avoid as far as possible the use of Art 356. Everybody now advocates and accepts the need for encouraging the process of resolution of inter-state disputes through mutual agreement, consensus

and compromise on the part of the parties to the dispute.

The Indian unitarian-federalism is now developing a competitive-bargaining dress. No doubt the traditional tension areas of Indian federalism still persist, yet there has emerged a new hope for resolution of at least some issues because of the dawn of the era of coalition rule at the centre in which a leading national level party form an alliance with several other regional parties for getting the power to rule. The development has started influencing the course of centre-state relations. The chances for the emergence of competitive-bargaining federalism ~~in~~ place of confrontationalist federalism have emerged.
