Topic: Nutritional Value of mushrooms

Mushrooms are the fleshy, spore-bearing fruiting body of a fungus, typically produced above the ground or on soil or on any other substratum. Mushroom contains macronutrients that support a healthy immune system. It includes the nutrients like selenium which helps to make the body synthesizing antioxidants that prevent cell damage. It is a substitution diet without restricting any other vegetables or foods. Mushrooms also known as vegetable meat is providing nutrition to diabetics, man having hypertension, obesity etc. Mushroom contain a high amount of protein content with an average value of 23.8g/100 dry weight. Mushroom distribution or marketing in India is not in a strategic way or chain marketing procedure. The per capita consumption of mushroom is less than 10g per person in India which is too less than China. The present seminar is aimed to get knowledge about nutritional value of mushrooms and benefit to health so that students get awareness about its consumption.
