Activity Report -

Under the chairmanship of Prof H.K. Das the Dept. Seminar was conducted. Prof Gobind Ch. Mishra joined as a resource person of the seminar. Four number of seminar students presented their paper on the topic. Remaining students and staff of the department kept their opinion on the topic.

Abstract of the topic -

Sustainable aquaculture in our district has the potential to serve as a strong economic tool for rural development, ensuring social justice. The detailed study of various factor involved in fresh water aquaculture/aquaculture development reveals that the fish culture potential is very high. There is scope for increasing aquaculture production through semi intensive or intensive culture technologies. Ponds and bays have rightly been included in this paper.

Marketing is organised almost entirely by the private sector with some degree of Govt. organisation. Research aimed

increasing productivity and sustaining productivity gains in the long run to meet the demands of the growing population should be continued. Research on bird nutrition should be undertaken in order to develop cheap but good quality feed. Identification of potential behavioural constraints to sectorial growth is an equally important area of research.
