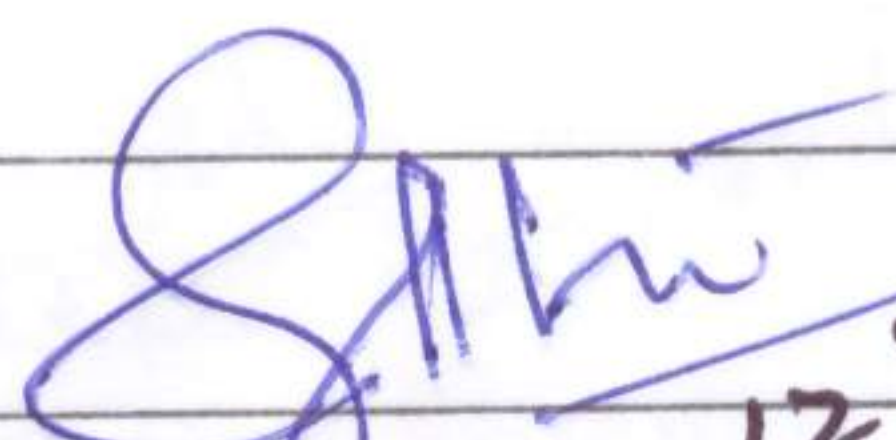

Name of the Seminar - "Is Preamble a part of the constitution of India?"

Activity report:-

Under the chairmanship of Prof. Sarat Kumar Mohapatra, the Dept. Seminar was conducted. Prof. Gayadhar Behera joined hands as a resource person of the Seminar. Six nos of students presented their paper on the topic. Remaining students & staff members of the Department kept their opinion on the topic.

Abstract of the Topic:-

While giving its opinion on the Presidential reference on the transfer of the Bernharti Union and exchange of enclaves, the Supreme Court held that "Preamble is a key to open the mind of the makers... nevertheless the preamble is not a part of the constitution". However, later on, it reversed its judgement in Kesavananda Bharati case and held that Preamble is the part of the constitution. Though it is not enforceable, yet it forms a part of the constitution.

The fact is that the Preamble is a basic part of the basic structure of the constitution. The Parliament also accepted it as a part of the constitution when it passed the 42nd Amendment which included an amendment of the preamble, and it was made in accordance with the provision of Art 368 of the constitution.

As such the preamble is not regarded as a part, a sacred and basic part of the constitution.

The preamble defines the basic structure of the constitution in India and is itself a part of the basic structure. It embodies the philosophy of the constitution and acts as a key to the interpretation of the constitution.

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
