

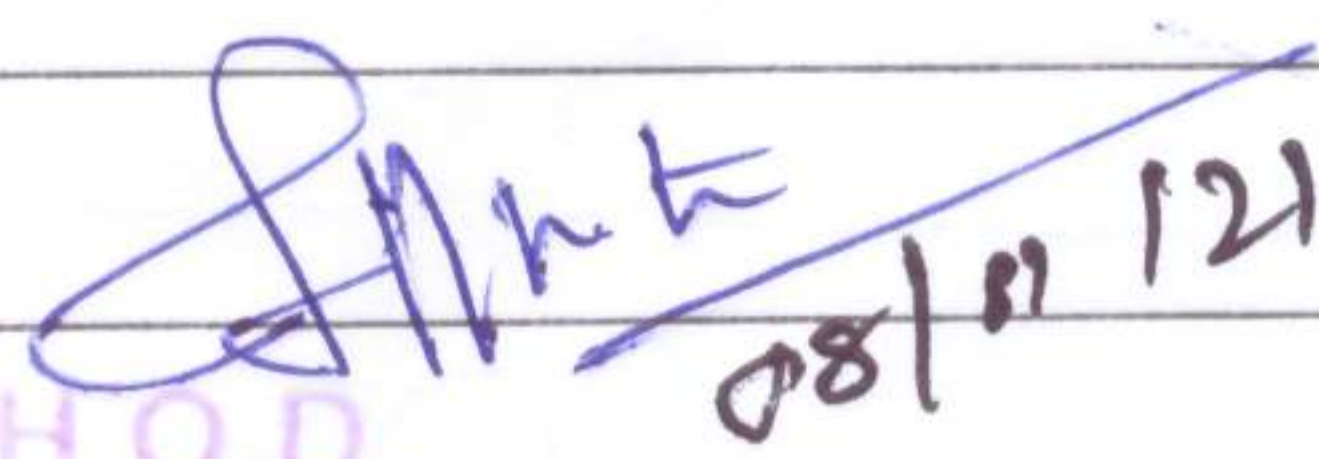

Activity report -

The Seminar was conducted under the Chairmanship of Prof. Sarat Kumar Mohapatra. Prof. Kamalakanta Biswal joined hands as a resource person of the Seminar and presented his view on the topic. Other faculties of the department also kept their opinion on the topic. Seven nos. of students presented their papers on the topic.

Abstract of the Topic:

Judicial activism means a proactive approach of the judiciary towards prevailing Socio-Economic, Politico-administrative conditions in the country. It is aimed at securing a due implementation of laws, policies and programmes by the Executive. It constitutes a bold attempt on the part of the judiciary to act as the effective guardian of Law by acting to check Executive and Legislative apathy.

However, while pursuing judicial activism, the judiciary must act more vigorously for eliminating judicial delays. It must make judicial procedures simple and less expensive. A plan for deciding pending cases must be formulated and implemented without any further delay. Fast Track Courts have been indeed helping this process.

There exists a big need to make the functioning of all courts more efficient and active. This must be included in the agenda of Judicial activism being pursued by the Judiciary.

More over, while pursuing Judicial Activism, the Judiciary should refrain from overstepping its jurisdiction. It should in no way come in conflict with the Legislative and Executive.
